INTELLIGENCE REPORT – INTERNATIONAL INTERVENTION IN TAKISTAN

The Foreign Intelligence Service of Chernarus (FISC) has gathered, through multiple sources including human intelligence (HUMINT), signals intelligence (SIGINT), and satellite analysis, information suggesting the imminence of a foreign military operation in Takistan aimed against the regime led by Azil.

According to the data obtained, an international coalition led by the United States and supported by NATO allies is in an advanced stage of operational planning. Identified strategic targets include critical infrastructure of the Takistani state, such as industrial complexes, energy production facilities, logistical nodes, and major urban centers. The nature of the operation shows tactical and strategic similarities to the military intervention carried out in Iraq in 2003, suggesting a possible “shock and awe” approach to rapidly destabilize the regime.

Reports indicate a significant increase in military activity at regional bases, movements involving air and naval deployments, as well as an intensification of reconnaissance operations. Additionally, an increase in diplomatic and media rhetoric has been detected, potentially aimed at justifying an international intervention.

The collected information has been presented to the President of the Republic of Chernarus, who, following its evaluation, has authorized the activation of a covert intelligence-gathering operation on the ground. Consequently, the FISC has been ordered to deploy human and technical resources in order to verify, expand, and assess the accuracy of the data obtained so far.

For the execution of this mission, the FISC has designated “Yellow” Squadron, a special unit composed of highly qualified personnel. This squadron includes elite special forces members as well as FISC operatives currently stationed in embassies and diplomatic missions abroad. This combination of military and intelligence capabilities will allow operations in hostile environments with a high degree of discretion and effectiveness.

The total number of personnel assigned to the operation amounts to ■■■■ agents, whose identities, specific roles, and locations will remain strictly classified. Rules of engagement and operational protocols have been defined to prioritize

intelligence collection without compromising personnel safety or Chernarus' diplomatic position.

The primary mandate of "**Yellow**" Squadron includes:

- Infiltration into key areas of Takistani territory.
- Confirmation of the presence and movements of foreign forces.
- Identification of potential strategic targets.
- Assessment of the readiness level of Azil's regime forces.
- Establishment of local informant networks.

Any leak of information related to this operation will be considered a severe breach of national security and will be subject to the direct authority of the President of the Republic of Chernarus, who retains exclusive control over the disclosure, modification, or cancellation of the mission.

Developments will be monitored in real time, and periodic updates will be issued as new relevant intelligence becomes available.
